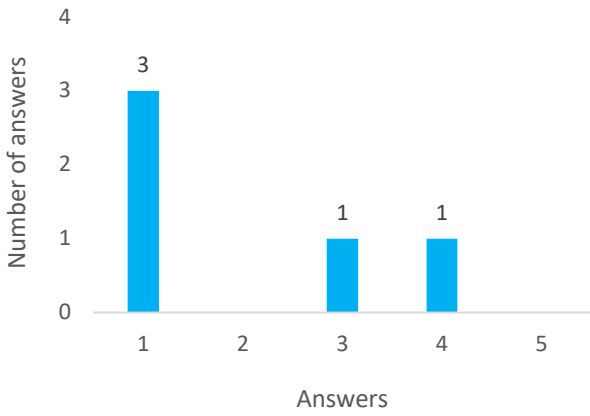


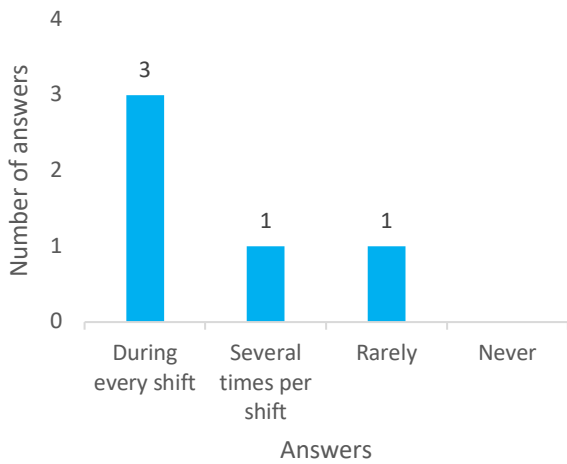
Q1: On a scale from 1-5, how difficult it is for you to identify different species?  
(1= easy; 5=very difficult)



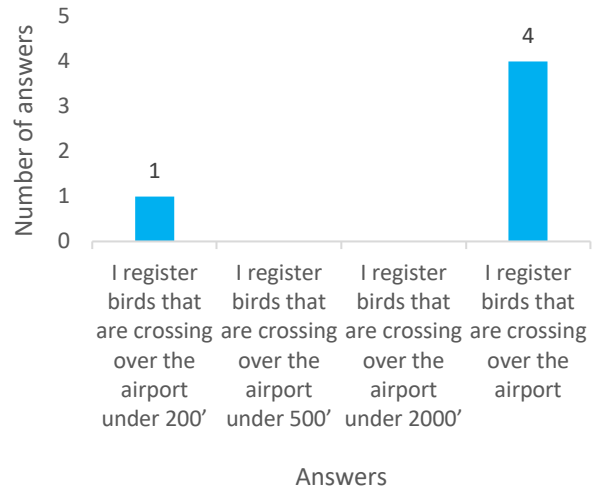
Q2: On a scale from 1-5, how important do you think it is to identify different species?  
(1=not important at all; 5= very important)



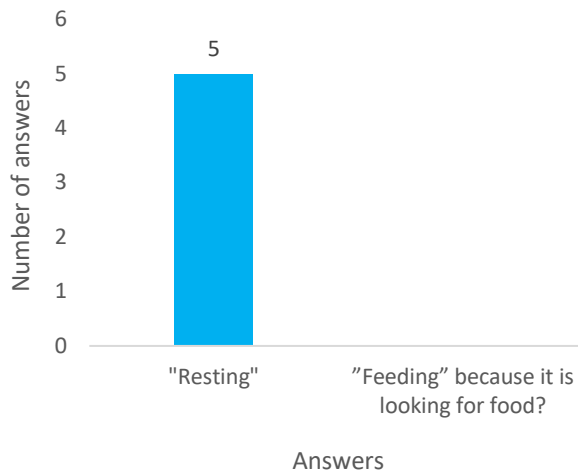
Q3: How often do you register more than 5 birds in the APP?



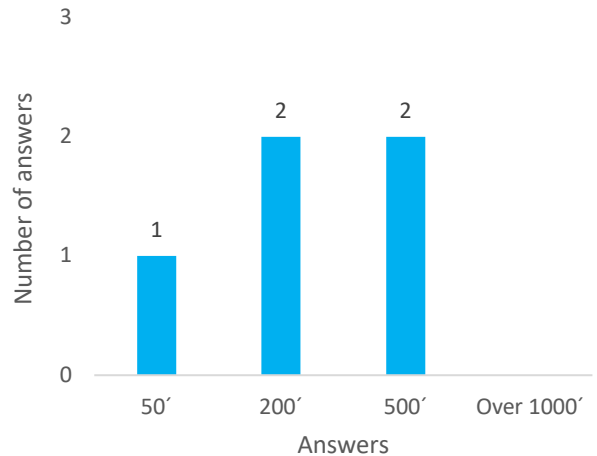
Q4: What does the term "Crossing-over" mean to you?



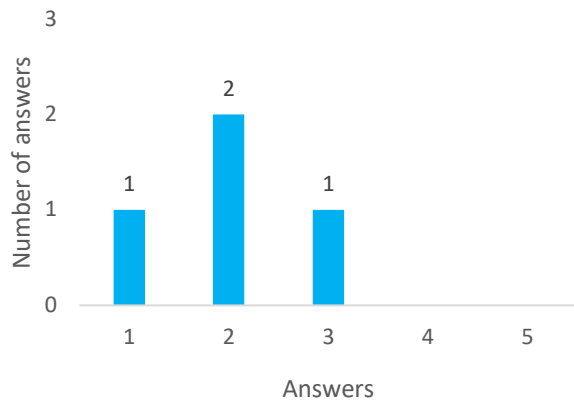
Q5: How would you register a bird of prey that is sitting on a pole?



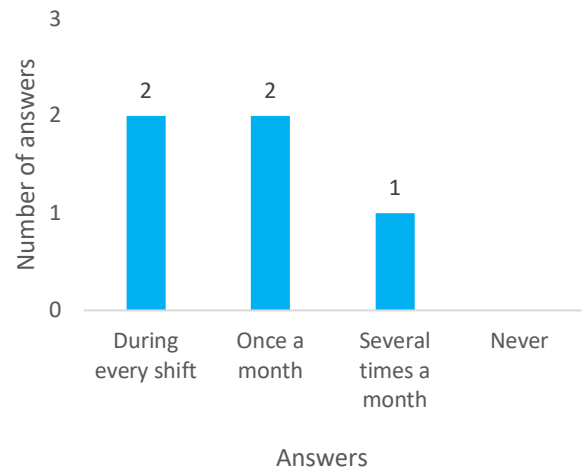

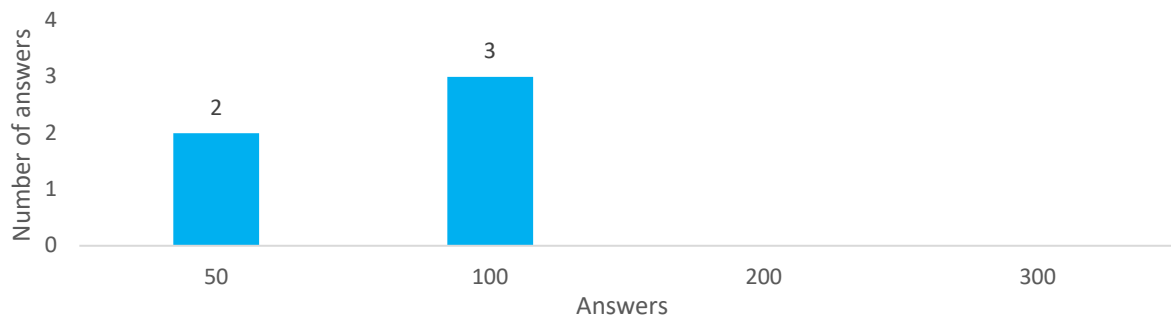

(1= Easy; 5=Very difficult)



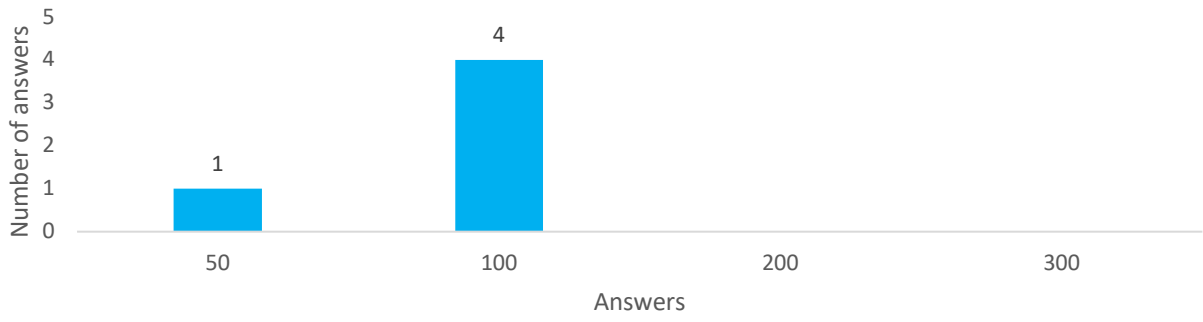

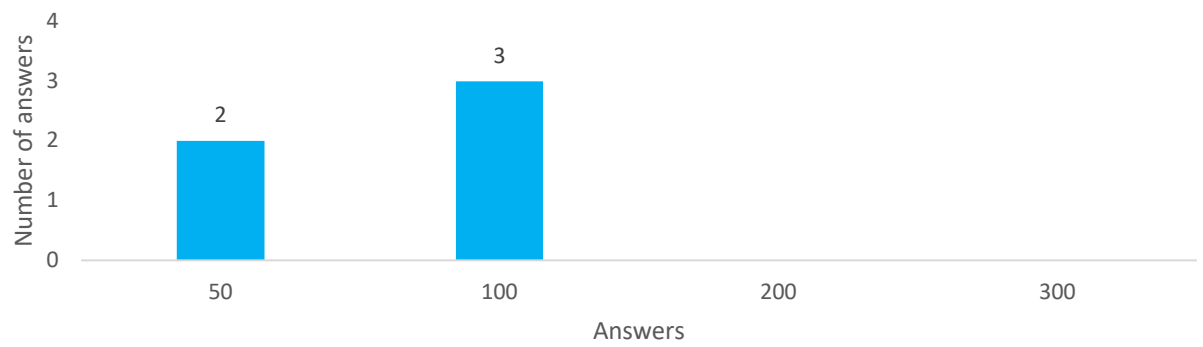
Q9: How many birds do you see approximately in the picture below?



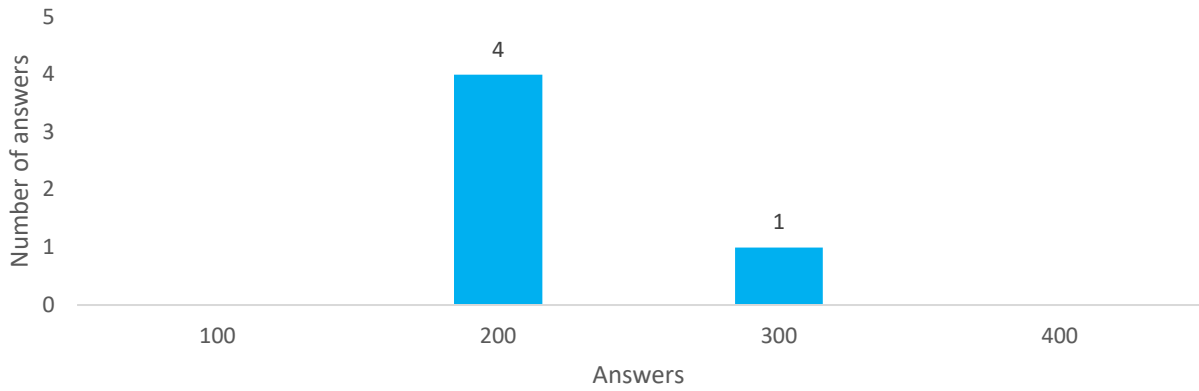

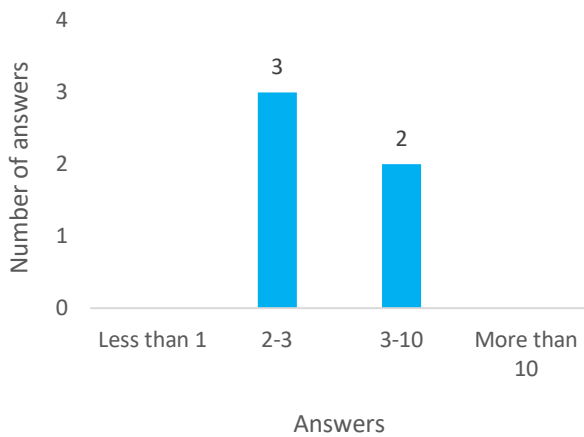

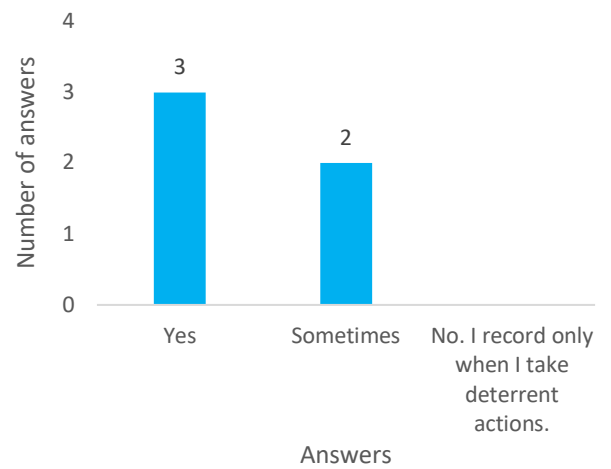

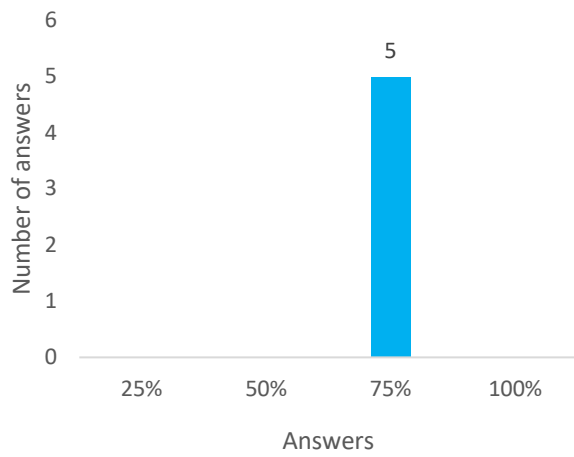
Q 13: How many recordings do you normally do on average per hour during your shift in the daylight?



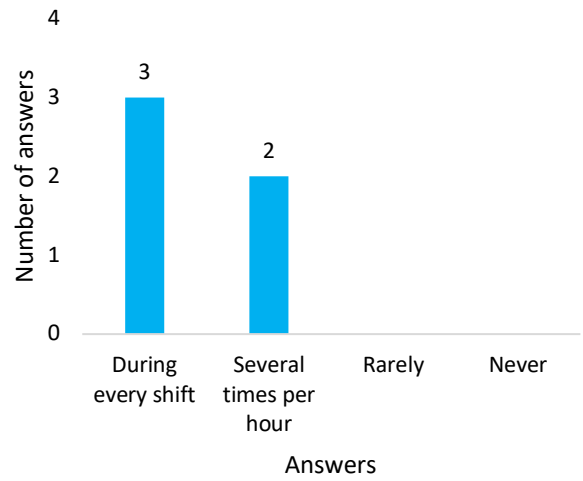
